

Thanks to the Network, it is counted with an **Action Plan** that recommends the actions of priority conservation that you can do to help this species not reach extinction.







¿Why was the idea of a recognition program born?



- Reports of bycatch of Dermochelys coriacea
- Videos the release of leatherback turtles
- Coordination with conservationists or local authorities to rehabilitate leatherback turtles.

Dissemination of the story and the prize assigned to the new hero, on the website and social networks of the Laúd OPO Network.













RESULTS



23 candidates were nominated



Heroes: 55% communities collaborating for several years in conservation.

Involved in decision-making spaces. 42 – 62 años


Guardians: 36% community members active at sea or on the beach. Guaranteeing protection. 40 – 45 años

Champions: 9% community members who are recruiting. They are adding followers to the cause.

IMPACTS OF HEROES

- Released alive: 6 individuals
- Research: 3 satellite marks located to track the migration route (2 adults and 1 juvenile)
- Logistics and coordination established in Mexico, for rehabilitation.
- **Distribution:** Greater number of juveniles reported in the southern zone. All stages in the nesting area.
- Political advocacy: they are participating in discussion tables of local government groups.
- **Knowledge:** They collaborate by making recommendations on sea turtle release techniques.



Fishing gear: 90% of interactions were reported in gillnets.


